

ARTICLE 3 – MEMBERSHIP

Section A – Qualifications/Categories

1. Each Oregon county *or affiliated State agency* may hold membership in the Association. ~~and must be represented by a county salaried employee.~~
2. *An affiliated State agency is defined as an agency of Oregon state government that has, by vote of the OACDP membership, been identified as a partner in conducting County business. Current affiliated State agencies are the Oregon Department of Administrative Services (DAS), Department of Corrections (DOC), Department of Human Services (DHS), Department of Justice (DOJ), Department of State Police (OSP), Department of Revenue (DOR), Office of the State Court Administrator, and Oregon Youth Authority (OYA).*
3. Each member ~~county~~ *organization* shall be entitled to one vote on formal matters presented to the Association at or outside of its regularly scheduled conferences, per Article 3, Section B. For business matters conducted by e-mail, at least 30 days advance notice will be given to all voting members prior to the voting period which will include 7 business days.
4. The Executive Board shall be empowered to establish associate memberships.
5. Associate Members shall have the privilege of attending all programs of the Association, except that they may be excluded from any business session of a regularly scheduled conference and will have no vote in the Association.

Section B – Delegates

1. A delegate is an individual attending a conference, who is authorized to represent a particular member ~~county~~ *organization*.
2. Delegates are divided into three categories: voting delegates; alternate voting delegates; and non-voting delegates.
3. A voting delegate is an individual authorized to cast the vote of a member ~~county~~ *organization*.
4. An alternate voting delegate is an individual authorized to vote during the absence of a voting delegate.
5. A non-voting delegate is any other person present from a member ~~county~~ *organization*.

Section C – Dues

The Executive Committee shall be empowered to establish dues for all categories of attendees. Subsequent raises in the dues will require a two-thirds (2/3) majority of all voting member counties.

Section D – Registration Fees

The Executive Committee shall be empowered to establish conference registration fees for all categories of attendees.
