Subject: Voting to Change OACDP Bylaws

The results of our electronic vote to change the OACDP bylaws are in. 11 counties participated in the voting - it takes 9 counties to constitute a quorum. The counties that participated include Clackamas, Clatsop, Deschutes, Douglas, Harney, Lincoln, Marion, Multnomah, Union, Washington and Yamhill.

The three proposed changes to the bylaws are listed below, along with the votes for each. It takes a 2/3 majority of the votes cast to change the bylaws - all three proposed changes were approved.

1) Shall the OACDP change Article 3 - Membership to allow membership in the OACDP by an "Affiliated State Agency"?

Total Votes cast - 11
Yes Votes - 10 (90.91%)
No Votes - 1 (9.09%)

2) Shall the OACDP identify the following eight (8) State agencies as an "Affiliated State Agency" - the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, Department of Corrections, Department of Human Services, Department of Justice, Department of State Police, Department of Revenue, Office of the State Court Administrator and Oregon Youth Authority?

Total Votes - 11
Yes Votes - 9 (81.82%)
No Votes - 2 (18.18%)

3) Shall the OACDP raise annual membership dues from \$50.00 to \$100.00 effective July, 2003?

Total Votes - 11
Yes Votes - 8 (72.73%)
No Votes - 3 (27.27%)
