

Oregon Centralized Voter Registration Steering Committee Meeting October 4, 2001

This was the first meeting of the Oregon Centralized Voter Registration (OCVR) Steering Committee. The 2001 legislature appropriated \$2 million out of a total estimated cost of \$7 million for a centralized voter registration system but because of the bleak revenue outlook, this \$2 million has been frozen. The money would have taken the project through the requirements, design, and early prototyping stages. It was decided to meet again in December where the Secretary of State's ISD representatives will present a scaled back proposal to the committee's legislative representatives, Sen. John Minnis and Rep. Kurt Schrader, who will take the new proposal back to the legislative leadership for review and possible release of funds.
